Subject: Response to questions

1. Is the material testing part of the scope of services? Is that a coordination or is that something that will be taken care of by the city?

It's the coordination. The city will have part of the services of our material testing laboratory. The city covers that under separate contract and independent lab.

2. Is there a reason why the PMP is a requirement for this?

This on-call is not only the construction management, but we will sometimes require PMP as part of the team because there may be a project including inspection services.

3. Can we use a PE in lieu of the PMP?

Yes, a licensed engineer (PE) can be an alternate.

4. Is the City going to choose only one firm? Or is there going to be multiple firms?

Multiple firms will be selected for this on-call. We anticipate 5 consultants.

5. Can we use projects that have been substantially complete? Like in the past ten years?

Yes.

6. Is the proposal to be filled in only by the selected consultants?

Yes, a proposal will only be required once the selected consultants have been notified of the final selection.

7. How many firms does the City anticipate selecting or has selected in the past on this RFQ?

The city anticipates to award this solicitation to 5 firms, similar to the number of selected firms in the past.

Yes, a licensed engineer (PE) can be an alternate.

9. Section III, Bullet-point 3 calls for a minimum qualification of, "The project manager for these services shall have a minimum of 7 years' experience in the management and administration of facility engineering, design and construction and shall be certified by the Project Management Institute as a Project or Program Management Professional." During the Pre-Bid Conference the question was raised if the City of El Paso CID would consider a Professional Engineer in lieu of Project or Program Management Professional designation and the City Representative seemed to be agreeable with this substitution. We would like to know if the second bullet-point could also be substituted, this bullet-point calls for, "The proposed construction manager shall possess a current Certified Construction Manager credential from the Construction Management Association of America (CMAA) and/or Certified Professional Constructor from the American Institute of Constructors, and a minimum of five (5) years of construction management experience for both vertical and horizontal construction with at least one (1) project having a minimum of \$2,000,000.00 construction budget," could this requirement be met by a Construction Manager having a Bachelor of Science Degree in Construction Management from an accredited University?

Yes. The minimum experience for each labor classification shall be as listed in Exhibit B.

Also, would a member firm of the CMAA fulfill this requirement?

Yes.

10. Do letters of Recommendation count as page count?

Yes, the only exception to the page count is resumes, cover letter, table of contents and dividing tab inserts. The Project Reference Forms will count as recommendations and are submitted separately.

11. Is any preference given for El Paso Tier 1 or Tier 2 local firms?

Tier 1 firms are preferred.
