Juvenile Case Management at El Paso Municipal Court



What is Juvenile Case Management?

Juvenile Case Management (JCM) is the process of providing services to first time offenders and/or at-risk youth. Services are to deter youth from committing more crimes or penetrating into the Juvenile Justice System (Juvenile Probation).

Services are determined at the time of the initial screening when risk factors are discussed and identified.

Three ways to obtain JCM Services

Intervention: Municipal Court Judge must court order the program. If juvenile complies with the program conditions, the citation will be dismissed.

Diversion: School Administrators or School Police can refer a student for a Class C Offense committed on school grounds to divert him/her from court. Complaint must be filed.

Prevention : Community Outreach presentations to schools and to the public to reduce behaviors that can lead to formal involvement in the Juvenile Justice System.

Program Services

Services/Classes include but are not limited to the following:

- ◆ Classes on :
 - Alcohol
 - Drug
 - Theft
 - Etiquette
 - Tobacco
 - Anger Management
 - Knowledge is Power
 - Misdemeanors
- ◆ Community (Service) Learning Projects
- ◆ Teen Court Program
- ◆ Offense-related/Reflection Essays
- ◆ Resource Referrals/ Counseling/Therapy
- ◆ Community Outreach Presentations
- ◆ School/Home Visits

Note: Program provides different levels of supervision and services. Level of supervision and services are determined at initial screening.

Administración de Casos Juveniles (JCM) es el proceso de proporcionar servicios para jóvenes que han ofendido por primera vez y/o que se consideran alto riesgo. Los servicios son para disuadir a los jóvenes de cometer más crímenes o penetrar el sistema de justicia juvenil (Juvenile Probation).

Los servicios se determinan en el momento del examen inicial cuando se discuten e identifican los factores de riesgo.

Intervención: Juez de la Corte Municipal debe ordenar el programa. Si el juvenil cumple con las condiciones de el programa citación será perdonada.

Desviación: Administrador de la escuela puede referir a un estudiante que ha cometido una ofensa Clase C en la escuela.

Prevención: Presentaciones a la comunidad, escuelas y el publico para reducir comportamientos que pueden llevar a un joven ser procesado por el Sistema de Justicia Juvenil.

- ◆ *Referencias para consejería o terapia*
- ◆ *Presentaciones a las escuelas*
- ◆ *Visitas a la escuela y al hogar*

Nota: El programa ofrece diferentes niveles de supervisión y servicios. Nivel de supervisión y servicios se determinara durante la primer visita.
