Priorities and Guiding Principles: The focus is on providing immediate shelter and long-term housing solutions for homeless veterans, coupled with comprehensive health and employment support.





Homelessness (Cont.)

Recommendations

- **Incentives for Landlords:** Encourage landlords to rent to veterans by offering incentives such as guaranteed rent, damage coverage, or tax benefits.
- Focus on Prevention: Implement programs aimed at preventing homelessness among veterans
- Integrated Service Delivery Model: Utilize the coordinating systems are already available for various services such as mental health care, substance abuse treatment, job training, and housing assistance.
- Long-term Support and Follow-up: Offer ongoing support and follow-up services to ensure that veterans remain housed and receive continuous care for any ongoing needs. Encourage organizations to share transparent, accurate, and timely data in the city, state, and nationwide.



Mental Health

Mission: Our mission is to move the mental health services and systems forward. We will advocate for a strong and expedient mental health care system that identifies challenges and promotes stabilization.

Vision: Our Veterans and Families experiencing mental health and substance abuse will have access to care options. Our Veterans and their Families deserve to have continuum of care, pathway to recovery, and integrated holistic options for lifelong success.

Priorities and Guiding Principles: Our Strategic Plan will prioritize services for mental health and substance abuse. It will focus on equity and access to care. It will create a holistic map of mental health options within our city to move from acute, to stabilization, to recovery.

Recommendations

- Work with community partners to prepare a Mental Health portion of the 2025 El Paso needs assessment questionnaire.
- Continue to participate and collaborate with crises intercept mapping governors challenge
 initiative to identify resources and best practices for mental health.
- Work with the Public Health Department to create a holistic map of mental health options within our city.



Employment

Mission: To recommend initiatives, programs, and legislation that will enhance employment opportunities for veterans, transitioning service members, and military spouses

Vision: Our Veterans, transitioning service members and military spouses will have access to meaningful employment options that will result in the retention and recruitment of military talent in the City of El Paso.

Priorities and Guiding Principles: Our efforts will be focused on facilitating opportunities for the transitioning service member and spouse population in and around El Paso in order to retain their valuable talent and experience in our community.



Employment (Cont.)

Recommendations

- Create a Spouse Fellowship Program in partnership with the City of El Paso and Hispanic Chamber of Commerce.
- Host a trades employment fair.
- Continue to support and build upon the existing city Veteran employment services.
- Use available city resources and leverage the city's relationships with the Hispanic and El Paso Chamber of Commerce, local businesses, Fort Bliss and beyond, advocating for hiring veterans and military spouses.
