On June 30, the El Paso City Council approved an ordinance calling for a ballot measure on the upcoming November 5, 2024 election.

The ballot measure will ask voters to decide whether to cancel the City's remaining authority to issue \$128,455,636 in general obligation bonds allocated for the Multipurpose Performing Arts and Entertainment Facility planned for downtown El Paso. In 2012, voters approved the issuance of these bonds to support the development of the facility.
