EL PASO, Texas—Save the date! The City of El Paso is ecstatic to announce the return of WinterFest—the largest winter festival in West Texas and Southern New Mexico—on Saturday, November 23!

The countdown has started for El Paso's most beloved signature festival that kicks-off the weekend before Thanksgiving through Sunday, January 5, 2025.

WinterFest is a one-of-a-kind holiday experience that includes the traditional lights parade, more than one million lights, massive holiday decor, live shows, an ice-skating rink, holiday shopping, family-friendly activities and programs, food trucks, delicious seasonal treats and more!

In preparation, the application period is now open for the lights parade participants, as well as food truck and vendors for the start of the season. Organizations, businesses and educational institutes interested in participating in WinterFest are encouraged to apply.
