# City Invites Public to Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony for Chelsea Pocket Park

## New Outdoor Space Funded by 2020 Capital Plan

**WHERE:** Chelsea Pocket Park, 819 Chelsea St.

The City of El Paso invites the community to a ribbon-cutting ceremony celebrating the completion of Chelsea Pocket Park, the newest addition to Central El Paso's public spaces.

The project, managed by the City's Capital Improvement Department, transformed the area into a vibrant pocket park featuring:

- A gathering space with a metal canopy
- Construction of new sidewalks
- Planting of new trees and shrubs along with the installation of a new irrigation system
- New lighting for the park
- Installation of park benches, picnic tables, trash receptacles, pet waste dispensers, and bike racks
- Parking area

Pocket parks like Chelsea offer significant benefits to the community by providing a welcoming space for social gatherings, recreation, and community engagement in areas where full-size parks aren't feasible.

With a budget of approximately \$1.5 million, this project was funded through the 2020 Capital Plan and aligns with the City of El Paso's commitment to enhancing quality of life through recreational, cultural, and educational opportunities.
