Hit and Run Driver Comes Forward

Date/Time: 09/10/2021 @ 9 P.M.

Location: 8000 N. Mesa

Pedestrian: Alonzo Lemus Rodriguez, 60 years of age, 6100 block of Doniphan

Driver: Hispanic male, 25 years of age, El Paso Resident

Vehicle: 2014 Toyota, Camry, Silver

EL PASO, Texas — On Saturday, September 11, 2021, at 1:10 P.M., the driver involved in this hit and run crash came forward voluntarily to the Westside Regional Command. The investigation continues at this time. Due to this reason, the driver's identity will not be released until the investigation permits. Special Traffic Investigators also found that Lemus Rodriguez was not crossing at a controlled intersection or crosswalk.

BACKGROUND:

On Friday, September 10, at 9 P.M., 60-year old, Alonzo Lemus Rodriguez was attempting to cross the 8000 block of North Mesa. As Lemus Rodriguez entered the southbound lanes of Mesa, a vehicle traveling in the center lane struck him and fled the scene. He was taken to the hospital with serious injuries.
