Guests can choose from five charming animal-themed scooters, including a black bear, dinosaur, rhino, shark, and even a unicorn. These whimsical FUR-wheelers are designed to enhance the Zoo experience, providing a comfortable and enjoyable way for guests to explore the grounds in style.
