## New Tool Shows Public Art Pieces in Neighborhoods

**EL PASO, Texas**— The City of El Paso Museums and Cultural Affairs Department is excited to announce the launch of a new website dashboard for the Public Art program.

“We’re excited to be launching the new website to increase the accessibility of our public art pieces for our community and visitors,” said Public Art Program Manager Miriam Garcia. “The public can visit the dashboard to learn more about the public art pieces in their neighborhoods and the public art program.”

The new website features an interactive map visitors can explore to see the locations of all public art pieces throughout the city. A detailed list highlights information about each piece including the artist, medium, and description. Each listing contains photos from multiple perspectives to allow users an opportunity to visually experience each art piece.

### About the Public Art Program

The Public Art Program is funded through a two percent set aside from the budgets of every capital improvement project within the City. Since it began in 2006, the Public Art Program has completed 86 projects. The program has worked with 377 artists, of which 77 percent are local artists.

The Public Art Program has worked with more than 175 local businesses, which have provided support services for the completion of the program projects. The program has received 11 national awards and has been featured in 18 National publications. The Public Art Program also established the Art Purchase Program which has 178 acquisitions to date.
