# Therapeutic Pool at Michelle T. Adjemian Recreation Center to Close Temporarily

## City to Install Humidifier to Improve Customer Experience

**EL PASO, Texas**— The City of El Paso Parks and Recreation Department will temporarily close the Therapeutic Pool at the Michelle T. Adjemian Recreation Center, located at 9031 Viscount Blvd, to enhance the overall customer experience.

Beginning Tuesday, September 3, the closure will allow for the installation of a new humidifier unit designed to control moisture levels at the indoor pool, ensuring a more comfortable and safer environment for all users. These upgrades are expected to be completed by early winter, barring any unforeseen delays.

During the improvement period, the recreation center will remain open, and all other services and programming will continue as scheduled. Residents are also encouraged to visit other City-operated Aquatic Centers during this time.
