El Paso Municipal Rose Garden to Open for Spring and Summer

EL PASO, Texas—The City of El Paso Parks and Recreation Department is excited to announce the reopening of the cherished El Paso Municipal Rose Garden on Saturday, March 1.

Located at 1702 N. Copia Street, the Rose Garden will be open daily from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. through November 30, and closed during recognized City holidays.

“It is that time of the year when the seasons change and the beautiful roses bloom at the Municipal Rose Garden. The iconic space adds to the natural beauty of our City and brings the community together,” said El Paso Parks and Recreation Department Director Pablo Caballero. “The Rose Garden represents our collective commitment to enhancing our public spaces and creating a lasting place for people to connect, enjoy, and appreciate the wonders of nature.”

About the Rose Garden

Spanning four acres, the El Paso Municipal Rose Garden is home to more than 1,400 rose bushes representing over 430 varieties. Visitors can stroll through scenic walking paths, relax on shaded benches, and admire the tranquil waterfalls nestled within the garden.

First opened in May 1959, the Rose Garden has flourished with the dedicated support of the El Paso Master Gardeners, who volunteer as part of a collaboration between the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service and the City of El Paso, in partnership with the El Paso Rose Society. Volunteers contribute to the garden’s upkeep by pruning, deadheading, weeding, and maintaining rose inventories, ensuring a stunning and welcoming space for all.
