DWI Offender Also Charged with Assaulting the Officer and Resisting Arrest

Date: June 15, 2022, at approximately 10:14 a.m.

Location: 12000 block of Castle Keep

Offender: 37 –year old Rogelio Fernando Guevara

Charge: Assault on a Public Servant Bond: \$10,000 Judge: H. Acosta

Charge: Resisting Arrest, Search or Transport Bond: \$1,500 Judge: H. Acosta

Charge: Driving While Intoxicated Bond: \$1,500 Judge: H. Acosta

El Paso, Texas — A 37 –year old man that had already been arrested for DWI and handcuffed, attempted to run away and assaulted the arresting officer. Rogelio Fernando Guevara was stopped at the 12000 block of Castle Keep for not having a vehicle registration sticker. Guevara was found to be intoxicated and handcuffed. While the officer was completing the DWI arrest procedure, Guevara attempted to run away. In the attempt to restrain Guevara both he and the officer fell to the ground and a violent struggle ensued during which time Guevara bit the officer. Use of a taser to subdue Guevara proved ineffective. The incident was captured by an area resident’s surveillance cameras and partially by an individual’s cell phone. Assisting officers arrived and secured Guevara who was booked into the El Paso County Detention Facility after getting medical clearance at approximately 10:20 pm. and released less than 3 hours later.
