# Motorcyclist is City's Latest Fatality

**Location:** Loop 375 MM42 (Pellicano Exit)

**Vehicle:#1** 2019 Harley Davidson  
**Driver:** 29-year-old Ramiro Munoz, resident of east El Paso, Texas **(Deceased)**

**Vehicle:#2** 1994 Ford Mustang  
**Driver:** 19-year-old Jordan Uribe, resident of Horizon, Texas

**El Paso, Texas**— This morning, Special Traffic Investigators were called out to assist in investigating a traffic fatality involving a motorcycle. The initial investigation revealed Uribe was traveling southbound on Loop 375 when Munoz ran into the rear of Uribe's Mustang at a high rate of speed. The impact caused Munoz to be separated from his motorcycle, where he slid across the pavement for several hundred feet. Uribe notified the police, and Munoz was transported to a local hospital. Unfortunately, Munoz did not survive the crash. The contributing factor in this collision is speed on behalf of Munoz. Munoz was not wearing a helmet at the time of the crash. This is the 75<sup>th</sup> traffic fatality this year compared to 67 at this same time last year. It should be noted that fatalities #73 and 74 were handled by the Texas Department of Public Safety.
