59th & 60th Traffic Fatalities

Date: 11-16-2024 **Time:** 12:30 AM
Location: I-10 W/B at Exit 19 B (Downtown Exit)
Vehicle 1: 2002 Silver Mitsubishi Montero
Driver: Jose Antonio Gutierrez, 56-year-old, El Paso TX Resident

Vehicle 2: Unidentified Silver SUV or Minivan with Texas plates.
Driver: Unidentified Hispanic male, 200-210 lbs. 5'10"

Pedestrian 1: 33-year-old Hispanic female (**Deceased**)

Pedestrian 2: 15-year-old Hispanic female (**Deceased**)

EL PASO, Texas—On November 16th, 2024 Special Traffic Investigations responded to a collision involving two vehicles and two pedestrians. The preliminary investigation revealed a Mitsubishi Montero was traveling West on I-10 at exit 19 B while both pedestrians were crossing I-10 South to North. The pedestrians crossed into the path of the Mitsubishi on the exit ramp and were both struck by the Mitsubishi. The second vehicle, which has not been identified, then struck the second pedestrian who was on the ground after being struck by the Mitsubishi. The El Paso Police Department asks if anyone has information on this incident to please call 915-832-4400 (non-emergency) or Crime Stoppers of El Paso at 915-566-8477 to remain anonymous.

Pedestrian on the roadway is a contributing factor in this collision.

These are the 59th and 60th traffic fatalities this year compared to 69 last year.
