Woman Arrested for City's 8th Traffic Fatality.

El Paso, Texas— The Special Traffic Investigations unit continues to investigate a fatal crash that occurred early Sunday morning. The preliminary investigation revealed Lopez was traveling southbound at the 8500 block of Dyer. Lopez rear-ended a Nissan Maxima that was stopped at a red light at Dyer and Tetons. Younis's vehicle was in the intersection and was hit due to the impact between the Ford Focus and the Nissan Maxima. Mr. Cryan, who was driving the Nissan, died at the scene. The driver of the Honda was uninjured, as was Lopez. Officers arrested Lopez for Intoxication Manslaughter. She was later booked into the El Paso County Detention Facility. This is the 8th traffic fatality this year as compared to 12 last year.
