6th Traffic Fatality in El Paso

Driver: 55-year-old Aurora Rey, resident of Central El Paso, TX (**DECEASED**) **Passenger**: 61-year-old Constancia Garcia, resident of Northeast El Paso, TX

EL PASO, Texas—The El Paso Police Department Special Traffic Investigations unit responded to a single-vehicle collision at the 6200 block of Railroad on February 7th. Preliminary investigation revealed that the driver of the Ford Expedition was northbound on Railroad. The vehicle veered to the right and went off the road, lost control and rolled over. Neither occupant were wearing seatbelts, therefore both were ejected. The driver and passenger were both transported to a nearby hospital with serious injuries. Unfortunately, on February 21st, the driver of the vehicle died from injuries sustained in the crash.

Alcohol is a contributing factor in this collision. This is the 6th traffic fatality of 2025 compared to 8 at the same time last year.
